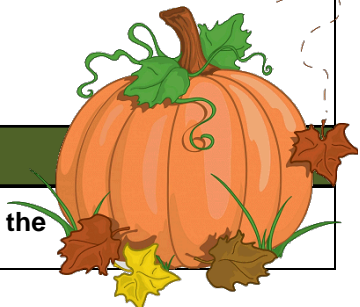

Boots to Business (B2B) Entrepreneurship Track: Seminar presented by the Small Business Administration (SBA) for those interested in pursuing owning a small business or franchise.

Capstone: Individual appointment with a Transition Counselor to ensure all Career Readiness Standards (CRS's) are met; required to finalize the DD2648 eForm. Commander and A&FRC verification/signature required.

Career Exploration & Planning Track (CEPT): (formerly CTTT) Provided by the Department of Labor and offers a unique opportunity to identify skills, explore a variety of tailored job recommendations, increase awareness of training and credentialing programs, and develop an action plan to achieve career goals.

Deployed Families Event: Events that take place once a month and are for families of deployed members only. The events offered are: Movie Nights, Bowling Events, Skate Nights, Swimming/Pool Parties, Amusement Park Day Trips, BBQs, Dinner Events, Holiday Parties, and Back to School Events. All events are free of charge.

German Culture Orientation: A class that is beneficial for newcomers, recently arrived at Ramstein/Germany, to receive information on German culture, customs, courtesies, and laws. Orientation covers important facts regarding living off base, contracts (rental, internet, phone), recycling, VAT, utilities, bills, and banking. Other topics include traveling throughout Germany and Europe, as well as shopping on the economy, and off-base leisure activities. Free lunch is provided.

Heart Link: An Air Force adaptation and networking program targeted to Air Force spouses of less than 5 years. This orientation "links" new spouses to other new spouses and targeted topics to help assimilate into Air Force/Military life, while connecting spouses with resources accessible throughout their life as a military spouse

Key Leaders Immersion Briefing: Required for Commanders, First Sergeants and Command Chief Master Sergeants who have recently been assigned to the KMC. New leaders should attend within the first 30-60 days of arrival. Additional duty first sergeants and superintendents can attend on a space available basis.

Key Spouse Monthly Luncheon & Training: Monthly training opportunity for Key Spouses. Different topics each month. Location is O'Club unless stated otherwise.

Newcomers Base INTRO (Enlisted Club): Military members are required to attend this mandatory newcomers briefing within the first week to 10 days after arriving to Ramstein. Spouses are welcome to attend.

Personal Financial Readiness for First Term Airmen (FTAC): Introductory financial education for Airmen E1-E3 whose first duty station is Ramstein AB. Topics covered are: budgeting, financial goals, car buying saving, investing, TSP, BRS, credit, debt management, and available financial resources. Held at the First Term Airmen Center

Pre-Deployment Briefing: Mandatory briefing required for deployers prior to leaving home station. Attendees receive education on how to best prepare themselves and their families for a successful deployment. The pre-deployment outprocessing checklists of attending deployers will be signed. Spouses are highly encouraged to attend the briefing.

Reintegration Briefing: Mandatory briefing required for re-deployers to attend within 5 days of returning to home station from deployment. Attendees receive education on how to reintegrate back with their families, friends, and co-workers. The reintegration checklists of attending re-deployers will be signed. Spouses are highly encouraged to attend the briefing.

Transition GPS Workshop: Mandatory 5-day workshop helps you prepare for the many military to civilian transition challenges. Workshop is presented by the Departments of Labor, Veterans Affairs and Defense. Topics: career decision-making, job search skills, translation of military skills into civilian terminology, resume writing, transition budget (finances), veterans' benefits, and more. **Pre-Separation counseling must be completed before registering for the workshop.**
