<u>**Capstone:**</u> Final step in the Transition Assistance Program process. Conducted on Thursdays from 0800-1000 on a walk-in basis. Must be in uniform and have ALL items on the Capstone checklist. A Transition Counselor will ensure all Career Readiness Standards (CRS's) are met and this results in the DD2648 eForm required to out-process. Commander and A&FRC verification/signatures are required.

Deployed Families Event: Events that take place once a month and are for families of deployed members only. The events offered are: Movie Nights, Bowling Events, Skate Nights, Swimming/Pool Parties, Amusement Park Day Trips, BBQs, Dinner Events, Holiday Parties, and Back to School Events. All events are free of charge.

EFMP Event: Each month, the EFMP-Family Support program hosts an event that provides an opportunity for families enrolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program to come together in a fun and supportive environment. For more information, please contact the EFMP-Family Support specialist

<u>German Culture Orientation</u>: A class that is beneficial for newcomers, recently arrived at Ramstein/Germany, to receive information on German culture, customs, courtesies, and laws. Orientation covers important facts regarding living off base, recycling, VAT, utilities, bills, and shopping.

Key Leaders Immersion : Required for Commanders, Command Chief Master Sergeants and First Sergeants who have recently been assigned to KMC. New leaders should attend within the first 30-60 days of arrival. Additional duty first sergeants and superintendents can attend on a space available basis.

<u>Key Spouse Refresher Training</u>: Mandatory one hour training for Key Spouse Mentors (KSM) and Key Spouses (KS) who had initial training in the past, but now are newly appointed as Key Spouses in Ramstein. Must bring a copy of the appointment letter to the training. **Spouse Sponsorship:** Get the tools you need to be a great spouse sponsor!This class will provide information, resources and networking for those interested in becoming spouse sponsors!

<u>Newcomers Base INTRO (Enlisted Club)</u>: Military members are required to attend this mandatory newcomers briefing within the first week to 10 days after arriving to Ramstein.Spouses are welcome to attend.

Newcomers USO Tour: This tour will begin at the USO in the passenger terminal. The tour will take you into the local community where there will be a walking tour of the city, lunch (at your own expense), a visit to and orientation of the train station and learn about the American influence on the local area. Pre-Deployment Briefing: Mandatory briefing required for deployers prior to leaving home station. Attendees receive education on how to best prepare themselves and their families for a successful deployment. The pre-deployment outprocessing checklists of attending deployers will be signed. Spouses are highly encouraged to attend the briefing.

<u>Pre-Separation Counseling Briefing for Retirees:</u> Mandatory briefing for members retiring from the military. Must be completed NLT 90 days before date of retirement (DOR). Retirees must be within 24 months of DOR.

<u>Pre-Separation Counseling Briefing for Separatees:</u> Mandatory briefing for members separating from the military. Must be completed NLT 90 days before date of separation (DOS). Must be within 12 months of DOS.

<u>Transition GPS Workshop</u>: Mandatory 5-day workshop helps you prepare for the many military to civilian transition challenges. Workshop is presented by the Departments of Labor, Veterans Affairs and Defense. Topics: career decisionmaking, job search skills, translation of military skills into civilian terminology, resume writing, transition budget (finances), veterans' benefits, and more. **Pre-Separation counseling must be completed before registering for the workshop.**
