Volunteer Code of Conduct

- 1. The consumption of alcohol, or other mind altering substances, is prohibited throughout the duration of the event you have volunteered for. This includes overnight trips.
- 2. Foul language will not be tolerated. Volunteers are expected to communicate in a professional manner while volunteering.
- 3. Ensure punctuality for each event you volunteer for. This usually requires arriving before patrons. Often, trips and events require tasks to be completed before clients arrive, and it is important to accomplish those to depart on time.
- 4. Volunteers are expected to practice the seven "Leave No Trace" principles and set a good example for clients to imitate.
- 5. Volunteers are expected to follow all safety procedures the trip leader has briefed and to remind clients to follow them as well.
- 6. Volunteers are expected to treat all clients with dignity and respect. If an interpersonal conflict arises, deescalate the situation and inform the trip leaders.
- 7. Clearly communicated expectations are the keys to success. Before departing, ensure you understand what the trip leader expects of you. It is important to reflect on performance. Talk to the trip leader after the trip to learn what went well and what needs improvement. The largest room in the world is the room to improve.
- 8. If you cannot make your commitment, inform the trip leader immediately.
