<b>**Registration required by contacting the M&amp;FRC**</b>	
<b>Civilian Resume Writing</b>	Learn how to identify transferable skills, create a career catalog, and create a draft resume.
<b>Deployment Reintegration (Video)</b>	Required for all service members returning from deployment. Please complete certificate and email to M&FRC org box and CC your UDM. Video may be accessed here: <a href="https://86fss.com/afrc/training-videos/">https://86fss.com/afrc/training-videos/</a>
<b>Ditching the Dorms</b>	Workshop to assess if Airmen are financially ready to move out of the dorms and onto the economy. <b>**Contact your Dorm Manager to register**</b>
<b>EFMP FS &amp; Hearts Apart Christmas Market for Adults</b>	This event is for Adults of EFMP & Hearts Apart to connect and explore Rudesheim & Mainz for Holidays. *No childcare provided & limited spaces
<b>EFMP-FS Sensory Holiday Shopping</b>	EFMP FS is partnering with the BX to provide an experience that is supportive of authorized patrons with differing abilities by having an Early Bird Shopping event.
<b>Federal Employment Workshop</b>	Prepare for federal employment by understanding resume writing and hiring practices.
<b>First Duty Station Enlisted (FTAC)</b>	Goal Setting and budgeting, credit and debt management, car buying, banking and checkbook management, and basic investing.
<b>First Duty Station Officer</b>	This mandatory class is designed to increase the financial readiness skills of first-duty station officers. Topics discussed include pay and entitlements, allotments, digital footprints, saving and investing, building credit, and family financial readiness. Members must attend within 90 days of arrival to Ramstein.
<b>German Culture Orientation</b>	Class is beneficial for newcomers, recently arrived at Ramstein/Germany, to receive information on German culture, customs, courtesies, and laws. Other topics include travelling throughout Germany and Europe, as well as shopping on the economy, and off-base leisure activities.
<b>Hearts Apart/EFMP Wood Craft</b>	EFMP family members & dependents of deployed service members join us for holiday wood crafts at the Arts & Crafts Center.
<b>Home Buying</b>	Buying a home is one of the most significant purchases you will make. This workshop is designed to increase the knowledge and comfort level of first time homebuyers and a refresher for the repeat home buyer.
<b>Key Spouse Continuing Education</b>	Key Spouses and Mentors are being educated by a base resource and given an opportunity to engage with base leadership.

<b>Paying for School Can be Cool</b>	Learn about how Active-Duty Military and DoD Civilian Employees may qualify for Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF).
<b>Plan My Move</b>	This workshop prepares members and families to PCS.
<b>Pre-Deployment Briefing</b>	Overview of deployment fundamentals and programs and services available to member and family members (Email).
<b>TAP: Pre-Separation Counseling *Virtual*</b>	The second step in the TAP process. Should be completed NLT 365 days from DOS/DOR. Will receive information on resources and programs they may be eligible for as transitioning service members. Prerequisite: Initial Counseling.
<b>TAP: 3-Day Workshop *Virtual*</b>	The 3-day Transition Workshop includes Pre-Separation brief, DoD/AF day, DOL 1 Day Employment Workshop, and VA Benefits and Services briefing. Workshop is designed to prepare military members and their families as they transition to the civilian sector. Prerequisite: Pre-Separation Counseling.
<b>TAP: Employment Track</b>	DOL Employment track designed to teach retiring and separating service members valuable employment seeking skills such as: Resumes, cover letters, application processes, LMI, social media use, networking, and much more.
<b>TAP: Entrepreneurship Track</b>	Conducted by the Small Business Administration (SBA). Service members pursuing self-employment in the private or non-profit sector will learn about the challenges faced by entrepreneurs, the benefits and realities of entrepreneurship, and the steps toward business ownership. *USAFE-wide virtual class not through Ramstein AB.*
<b>Thrift Savings Plan</b>	Join the M&FRC as we discuss the ins and outs of the Thrift Savings Plan.
