


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Workshop	Description

First Duty Station Officers- Financial Readiness	This is a mandatory briefing for all first duty station lieutenants. Briefing provides financial education for first term officers and the troops they will be entrusted to supervise. Information regarding basic financial management and relocation resources will be provided.
German Culture Orientation	Understanding German culture; driving; recycling; customs. Information from German American Community Office; Polizei; VAT/UTAP office.
Heart Link	Dept of the Air Force 101 for new spouses. Day filled with activities, networking with helping agencies, learning about AF culture/programs and building resiliency.
Interviewing Skills	Preparation is key for a great job interview. This two-hour workshop provides tips and coaching for job interviews and handling those hard-to-answer questions. Key Leadership Immersion	Newly appointed leaders will receive required briefings by agencies to include but not limited to Mental Health, IG, Wing Safety, EEO, SAPR, M&FRC.
Key Support Liaison (KSL) Continuing Education/Annual Training	Continuing Education: Base resource education for Key Support Liaisons (KSLs) with an opportunity to engage with base leadership. KSL Annual Training: Sexual Assault Prevention & Response and Suicide Awareness Training are required annually for all KSLs.
LinkedIn Job Search	Offers insider knowledge to utilize LinkedIn's job search features. Participants learn how to set job alerts, connect with new people, join groups, and follow organizations to grow their networks. Resume Essentials	A workshop designed to create your most effective resume for the career you want. Trained facilitators will provide guidance and teach you to evaluate your resume and understand job application techniques. Resume Review	A workshop study hall where participants can utilize the time to work on a resume in house or have their resume reviewed by M&FRC Staff. *Pre-requisite is to attend Resume Essentials or Navigating USAJOBS.
Salary Negotiations	Learn salary and compensation negotiation skills. Taught by Department of Labor. *Virtual classes available at https://www.dol.gov/agencies/vets/programs/tap/teams-workshops *
Saving and Investing	Join the M&FRC as we discuss saving vs. investing. This class is open to military members, civilians, and family members.

TAP: 3-Day Core Curriculum Workshop	The 3-day Transition Workshop includes DoD/AF day, DOL 1 Day Employment Workshop, and VA Benefits and Services briefing. Workshop is designed to prepare military members and their families as they transition to the civilian sector. Prerequisite: Mandatory Initial Counseling and Pre-Separation Counseling.
TAP: Education Track	This is the two-day track for service members, spouses and dependents to attend to learn about furthering their education.
TAP: Employment Track	DOL Employment track is designed to teach retiring and separating service members valuable employment seeking skills such as: Resumes, cover letters, application processes, LMI, social media use, networking, and much more.
TAP: Entrepreneurship Track	Conducted by the Small Business Administration (SBA). Service members pursuing self-employment in the private or non-profit sector will learn about the challenges faced by entrepreneurs, the benefits and realities of entrepreneurship, and the steps toward business ownership.
TAP: Pre-Separation Counseling	The second step in the TAP process. Should be completed NLT 365 days from DOS/DOR. Service members will be counseled based on the pre-separation counseling script. Will receive information on resources and programs they may be eligible for as transitioning service members. Prerequisite: Mandatory Initial Counseling.
TAP: Vocational Track	This track taught by DOL helps to identify skills, increase awareness of training and credentialing programs, and develop an action plan to achieve career goals.
VA Benefits 101	Bring your lunch and join us for a workshop that highlights VA Benefits and Services available for service members and their dependents. Topics include: Education, Home Loan Guarantee, Healthcare, Insurance and Memorial Benefits. OPEN TO ALL!
