Workshop	Description
Conversation Corner with EFMP	Conversation Corner with EFMP is a joint Air Force/Army group to meet new friends, explore valuable information, & gain support by sharing experiences. Guest speakers from installation helping agencies present on occasion. Alternate locations throughout the KMC.
EFMP and Hearts Apart Holiday Craft	Join EFMP-FS & Hearts Apart for a holiday craft event featuring festive painting projects.
Crushing Debt	This course is designed to empower you and your family to get out — and stay out — of debt. You will learn proven techniques to overcome high interest rate consumer debt, make the most of the money you have coming in and get on track to a more secure financial future.
EFMP Toddler Play Group (0-18 months)	Play group offered at the Community Center for children ages 0-18 months.
First Duty Station Officers- Financial Readiness	This is a mandatory briefing for all first duty station lieutenants. Briefing provides financial education for first term officers and the troops they will be entrusted to supervise. Information regarding basic financial management and relocation resources will be provided.
German Culture Orientation	Understanding German culture; driving; recycling; customs. Information from German American Community Office; Polizei; VAT/UTAP office.
Home Buying	Buying a home is one of the most significant purchases you will make. This workshop is designed to increase the knowledge and comfort level of first time homebuyers and a refresher for the repeat home buyer.
Interviewing Skills (TEAMS)	Preparation is key for a great job interview. This two-hour workshop provides tips and coaching for job interviews and handling those hard-to-answer questions. Key Support Liaisons (KSL) Refresher Training	Training conducted for appointed Key Support Liaisons (KSL) who have previously been a KSL at another base.

TAP: Employment Track	DOL Employment track is designed to teach retiring and separating service members valuable employment seeking skills such as: Resumes, cover letters, application processes, LMI, social media use, networking, and much more.
TAP: Entrepreneurship Track	Conducted by the Small Business Administration (SBA). Service members pursuing self-employment in the private or non-profit sector will learn challenges faced by entrepreneurs, the benefits and realities of entrepreneurship, and the steps toward business ownership.
TAP: Pre-Separation Counseling	The second step in the TAP process. Should be completed NLT 365 days from DOS/DOR. Service members will be counseled based on the pre separation counseling script. Will receive information on resources and programs they may be eligible for as transitioning service members. Prerequisite: Mandatory Initial Counseling.
TAP: Vocational Track	Taught by DOL to identify skills, increase awareness of training, credentialing programs, & develop an action plan to achieve career goals.
